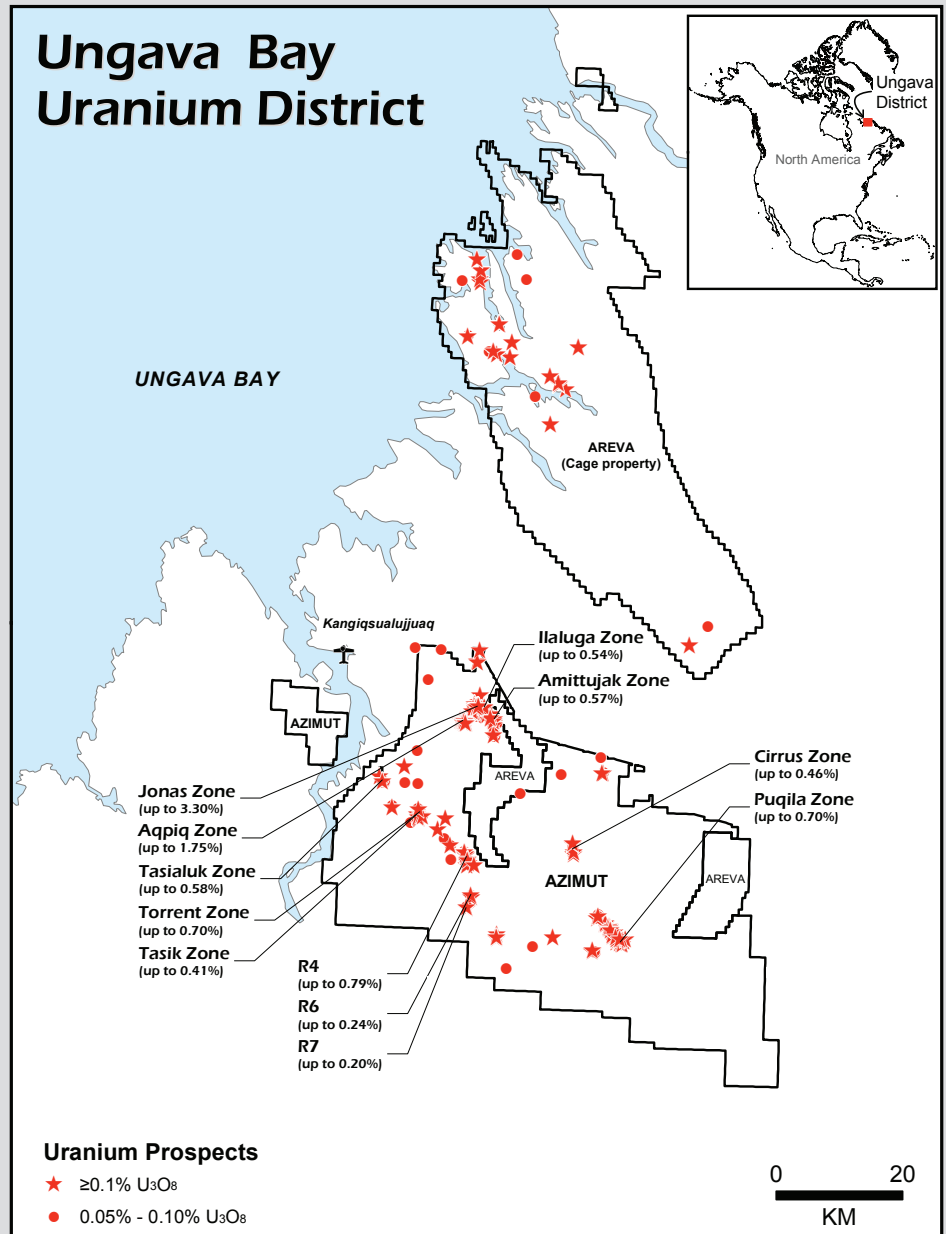


# Azimut on the hunt for uranium districts in Quebec

**Azimut Exploration Inc.** is a Canadian mineral exploration company trading on Toronto's TSX Venture Exchange (AZM-TSX-V). Azimut's proprietary targeting methodology uses advanced data processing to analyze vast regions and generate high-quality projects with a focus on uranium and gold. Partnerships are developed at an early stage to fast-track mineral development on multiple properties concurrently

## Azimut's outlook for uranium in Quebec

- Pro-mining climate and absence of political risk
- Outstanding potential for surface discoveries at competitive costs in largely under-explored regions
- Azimut is one of the largest uranium explorers in Quebec and its largest landholder with about 10% of the province's mineral claims
- **Ungava Bay region** (see map): the magnitude of uranium mineralisation discovered by Azimut – and by AREVA on their neighbouring Cage property – suggests that this region could become Canada's newest uranium district; outcropping mineralised zones on Azimut's properties form a cumulative length of 18 km with grades up to 3.3%  $U_3O_8$ , and mineralisation is mostly related to pegmatitic dyke swarms along a highly prospective Archean-Proterozoic contact with a 70-km strike length
- **Central Quebec region:** recognition of an extensive prospective trend about 350 km long; discovery of at least 86 showings with grades up to 3.01%  $U_3O_8$  related to granitic intrusions and late major faults
